WHEREAS: The first Commanding Officer of the Fayetteville Independent Light Infantry was Captain Robert Adam of Greenock Scotland, and many of our early members shared the same cultural heritage, and

WHEREAS: The Fayetteville Independent Light Infantry perpetuates its strong Scottish heritage which is reflected in an official kilted uniform, a Pipe Sergeant that serves in the Color Guard, an annual Scottish Heritage Worship Service held at the historic Longstreet Presbyterian Church, and the official Company drink---Drambuie, and


